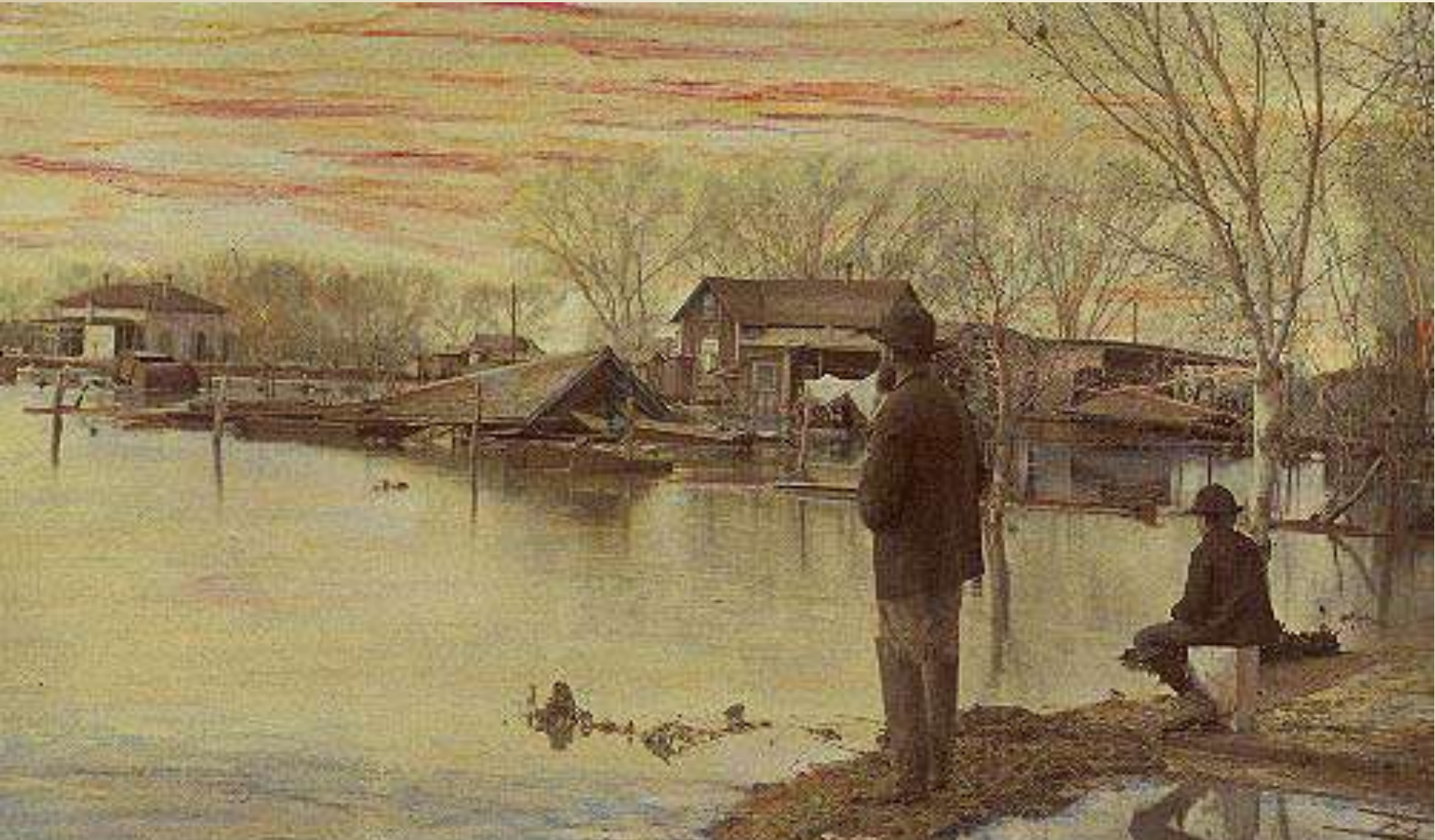

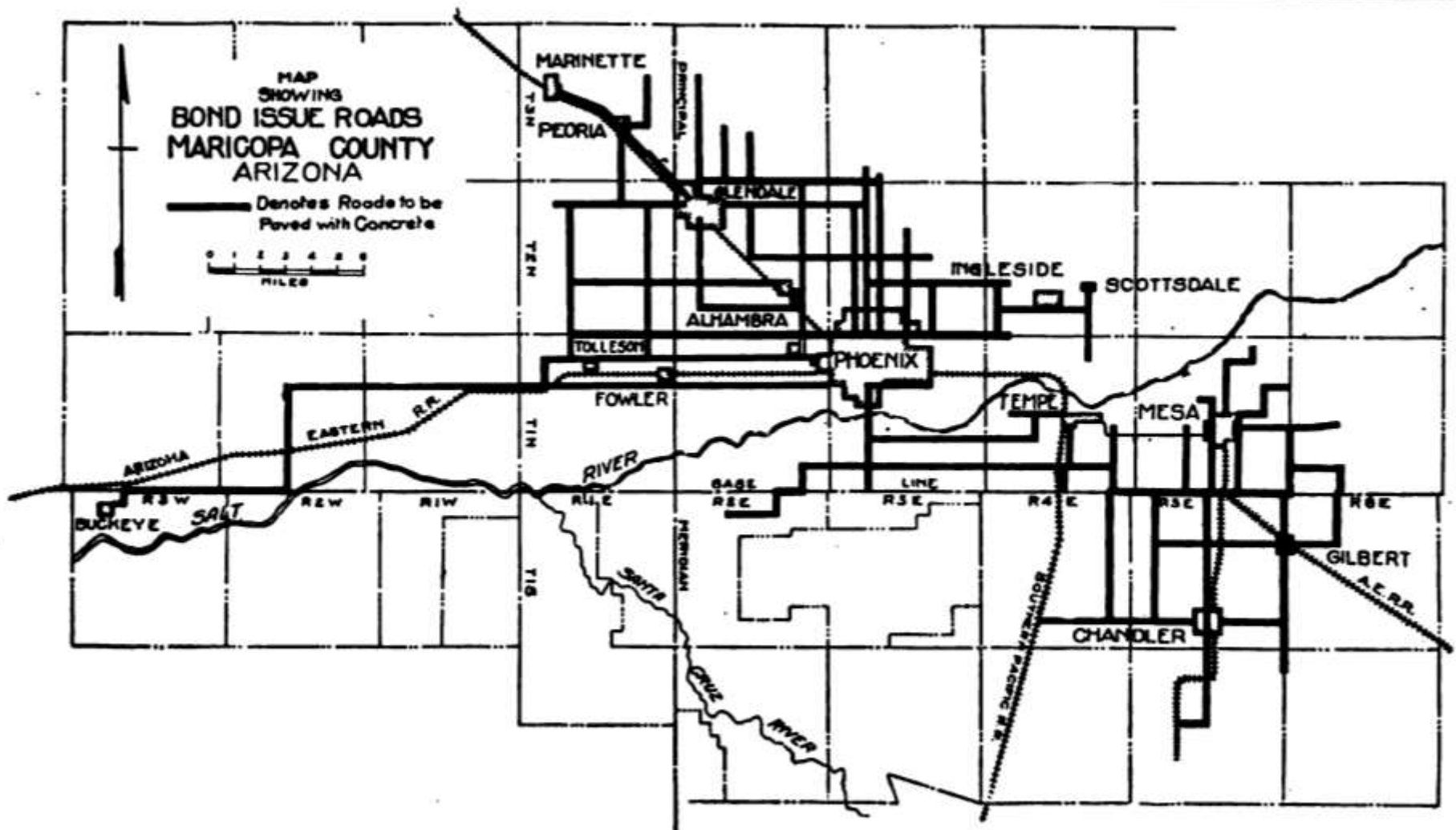

1957 First Concrete Interchange

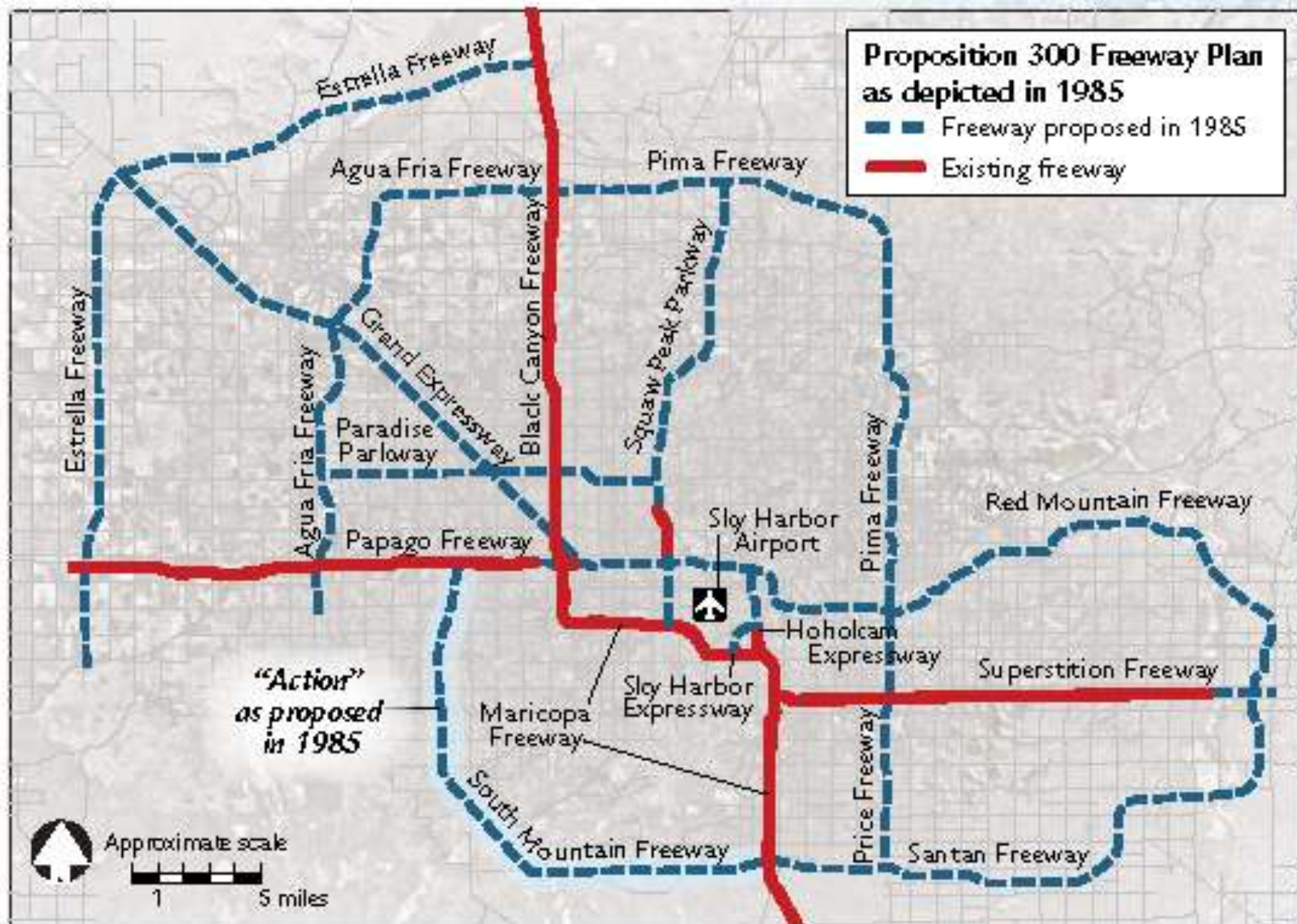

Note: The graphic below depicts the freeway plan as shown to voters in 1985.



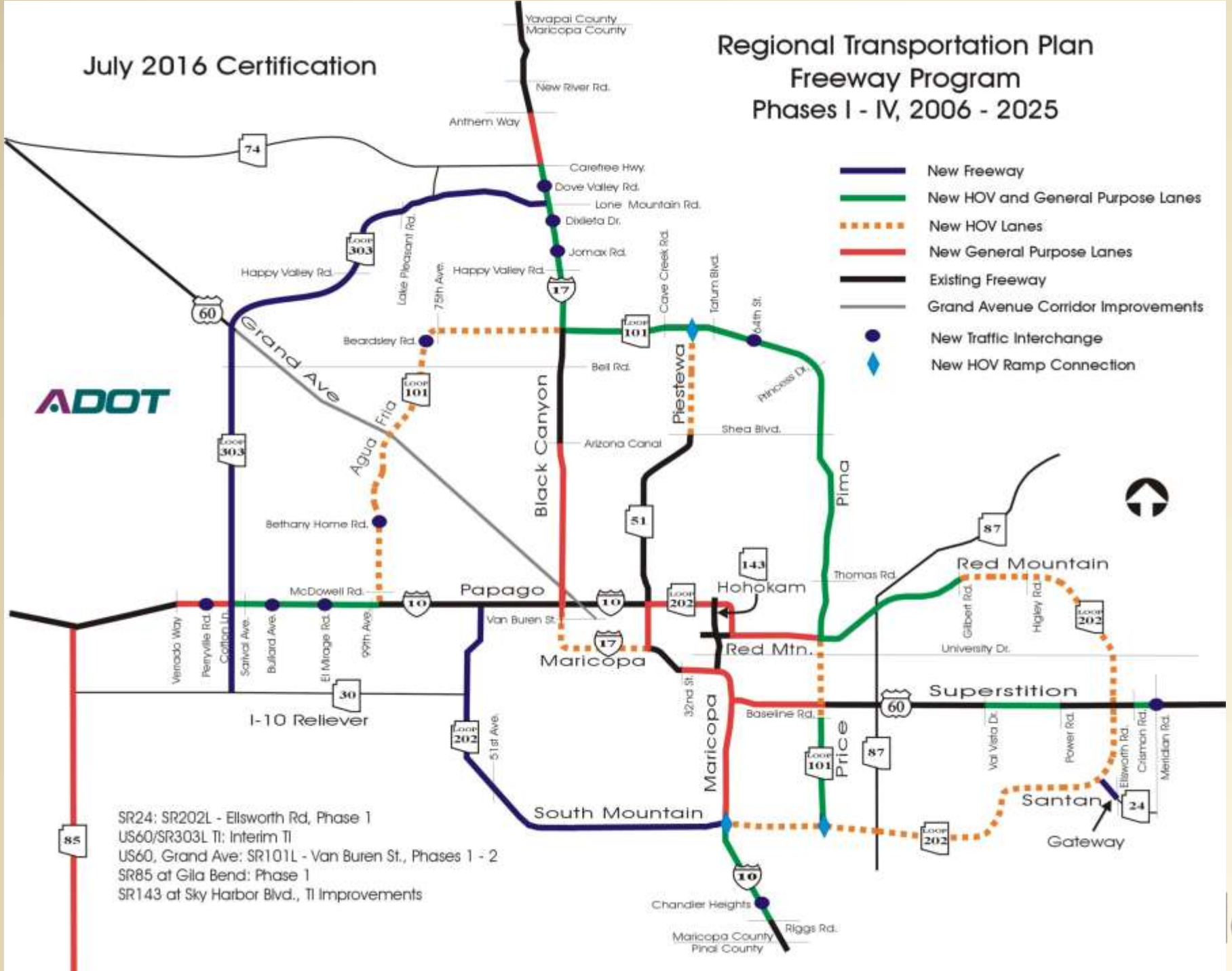
