

Economic expansion is heavily dependent upon quality transportation infrastructure








# Barriers to Adequate Surface Transportation Funding

- State's historic diversion of over \$1 billion in **Highway User** Revenue Funds to balance the **State Budget**
- Rising costs associated with aging infrastructure

Declining transportation revenue due to increased vehicle fuel efficiency and alternatively powered vehicles

#### How is Pima County responding?

- ▶ 2017 Legislative Agenda prioritizes transportation funding
  - Eliminate Legislative HURF Diversions
  - Increase the gas tax
  - Develop alternate, sustainable revenue sources
- ▶ Developing infrastructure for major employment expansion, growth
  - ► New Aerospace Parkway in Tucson's Aerospace and Defense Corridor
  - Supporting efforts for a new second runway at Tucson International Airport
  - Working with Union Pacific Railroad to connect rail to primary, technologybased employment centers
  - Successful public-private partnership with the Port of Tucson to secure TIGER grant funding for large train offloading with a new 8,000-foot rail siding and high-speed switch.
